This report should be submitted as outlined in your grant acceptance letter. The coordinator should include in this report an outline of how the OWF funds were used.

Electronic copies of the OWF logo will be provided for use in signage or other materials promoting the project.

Use of the final report and application details may be posted on our website.

<u>Approval</u>: Final approval of applications will be determined at the OWF Board of Directors annual meeting each summer. The application approval process is determined by several factors including, but not limited to, the value of the project to the local, regional, or provincial community, the necessity of the funds requested, and the amount of funding and support received from other sources.
